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Awful Auntie's Clothes

- Thick jacket, ideally tweed if you don't have one, then you could use any old coat.

 Plus four trousers or pyjama trousers pushed up and tucked into long socks work very well too
- Polo neck jumper or snood.
- Socks and boots.
- Glove or gauntlet.
- Accessories (see below).







You might like to try these accessories

Deer stalker hat - if you don't have one then you can cover a baseball cap in suitable material, using glue. If you want earflaps cut out two card ear flap shapes and cover them with matching material.

Monocle – if not available, draw a monocle shape on your face with a make-up pencil or face paint crayon.

Pipe optional.

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Making The Owl, Part 1



If you don't have a decoy owl or a toy owl, then you can make Wagner, the Great Bavarian Mountain Owl using cardboard.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Large sheet of card
- Marker pen
- Scissors
- Thin strip of card for loop on back of owl
- Stapler and staples



Making The Owl, Part 2

- 1. Copy the owl on page 16 or page 67 of 'Awful Auntie' or the image below.
- 2. Cut out very carefully.
- 3. Staple a card loop, cut to the right size for your arm, to the back of the owl (see below).
- 4. Arrange the owl on your bent arm (see below).
